**A Litany from Matthew 6**

“Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, or about your body, what you will wear.

“Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust consume and where thieves break in and steal; but store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust consumes and where thieves do not break in and steal.
